SAMPLE STUDENT EXAMINATION IN NATAL ASTROLOGY**

1. Erect a natal chart for a male born *August 30, 1950, Atlanta, GA, 33N45, 84W23, at 7:50 a.m. EST*. After calculating all house cusps to the nearest minute, enter the results on the outside of a tri-wheel form, and enter natal planets on *innermost* circle.
2. List natal declinations for the chart and fill in the aspectarian, including the parallels.
3.
 - a. Which was the last of all aspects made by Moon?
 - b. Which is the closest of all aspects in the horoscope?
 - c. What aspect is formed between Mars and the Ascendant?
 - d. Which will be the next of *all* aspects made by Moon?
4. Give the decanate in this chart, its subruler, and a brief descriptive phrase for: Sun, Moon, Ascendant, Mercury, and Midheaven.
5. Give a brief description of and the astrological reasons for the native's personality.
6. Give the planetary ruler of the fourth house and its aspects. Briefly describe the home environment.
7. Which houses become active under the stimulation of Mercury, Venus, Mars, Jupiter, and Saturn?
8. Which houses are the strongest and what do they rule?
9. What suggestions would you give him to handle the energies represented by Mercury square Uranus?
10. Give a brief description of his marriage house.
11. How would you judge the health of this man?
12. Erect a progressed chart for *July 15, 1968* and enter secondary progressions in the middle wheel. Also calculate the progressed declinations, including the Midheaven and Ascendant in 1968 at birth latitude.
13. Enter in the outer wheel the transits for *July 1, 1968 at noon at birth latitude*. Calculate the transiting declinations.
14. What important events could have happened to native in the year 1968? Give progressions within one degree of orb.
15. Select *one* progressed aspect within one degree of perfect in the chart as progressed and briefly explain what the native should do under this stimulation.
16. In what year of his life did progressed Venus oppose natal Jupiter?

17. How old was he when progressed Moon perfected its sextile to natal Ascendant?
18. How old was he when progressed Mercury made a conjunction to natal Neptune?
19. List six house cusps for native born *June 20, 1954, 42S54, 147E22 at 2:14:28 a.m., Hobart, Tasmania, Guam Standard Time*. Calculate all cusps to the nearest minute.
